# Instructions

**Applicant:** Please read these instructions carefully and complete all portions of the application. It is due by the *second Friday in April*. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Your application will be reviewed and ranked by Ruritan members who reside outside of the Lucketts area. This will remove any bias in the ranking. Scholarship winners and award amounts will be announced at the school awards assembly. Funds will be sent directly to the student account at the college as soon as the student's account is established.

**Eligibility:** You must reside in the Lucketts area which is defined as: "That part of Loudoun County bounded by Tutt Lane on the South, the Potomac River on the North and East and by the Catoctin Ridge on the West". In addition, candidates must be registered in Loudoun County as a home-schooled student or be enrolled in an accredited college or university and previously registered as a home-schooled student in Loudoun County while a resident of Lucketts.

4. **An essay** describing your goals and plans to achieve them.
5. At least two **Letters of Recommendation** (a separate PDF file)
6. **Your Transcript** is to be submitted by a public or private school if you have one. See page 3 for details.

Your parents or the person(s) responsible for overseeing your schooling should prepare this “transcript”. If you have provided a similar document to a college or university admissions office, a copy of that will be acceptable.
  2. Copies of any course completion certificates, including grades, for courses taken at or above the high school junior level.
