

Committee Structure

The Lucketts Ruritan Club is organized around Standing and Public Service Committees. Standing Committees support the regular operations of the Club, while Public Service Committees focus on efforts to support the Lucketts Community.

Standing Committees

- Fellowship – Plans events for Club members and their families
- Finance – Prepares the Annual Budget and oversees Club finances
- Membership - Recruits new Club members
- Program – Plans the program for monthly Membership meetings
- Public Relations – Manages communication through correspondence, social media and Club website.

Public Service Committees

- Business and Professional – Supports the activities of the local business community.
- Citizenship and Patriotism – Promotes patriotism and citizenship
- Environment – Works to enjoy and preserve the local environment
- Public Service – Operates the weekly Trash and Recycling operation on Saturday mornings.
- Social Development – Oversees outreach to the community through Scholarships, Grants, and other programs that support local citizens.

The figures below for 2022 show how members of the Club give back to the Lucketts community through public service activities. In addition, the chart shows how the Club reinvests 83% of the Club’s income in activities that serve the community of Lucketts.
